Congenital CMV: Prevention is in your hands

About the Course

This free course has been designed for midwives and midwifery students. It may also be relevant to other maternity health care professionals. The course provides information about CMV and congenital CMV, which is CMV infection passed from a mother to baby during pregnancy. The course aims to update you on how congenital CMV can adversely affect babies, and prevention strategies for reducing the risk of infection during pregnancy.

Upon completion of this course, you will be able to describe:

- what CMV is and how it is spread;
- what cCMV is and how it can affect babies;
- current recommendations for serological testing of maternal CMV;
- recommended prevention strategies for reducing the risk of CMV infection and transmission during pregnancy;
- the role of midwives in counselling pregnant women about CMV; and
- current CMV education resources.
