

MEDICATION AND DRUGS IN PREGNANCY



This course is designed for midwives who want to refresh their knowledge about providing antenatal care to women regarding medication and other drugs.

- Discuss the risks and implications of alcohol use during pregnancy with women.
- Summarise the risk and implications of other drug use with women.
